Diamond Hearts was incorporated in 2008 as the Diamond Hearts Foundation, Inc., a 501 (c) (3), not for profit public benefits corporation.

As international spokesperson for Diamond Hearts, Mr. Diamond set a mandate to empower over 1 million men and women around the world as Diamond Hearts. This will be accomplished in part with international Diamond Hearts service club organizations.
